'68 - '76 , A BRIEF HISTORY.

A lot of cricket has been played over the years at various locations in Brize Norton. But from the late 1950's, when the previous Club was disbanded, there was a long period of inactivity.

During the Summer of 1968 a meeting was convened and the decision made to go ahead with a limited programme of matches, the current season being already well under way. Upon this trial was based the conclusion that a full campaign in 1969 was a viable proposition. In the Winter the new organisation gathered momentum, raising funds and producing the first official fixture list for the next Summer.

In the early years the going was hard, the team of relatively inexperienced cricketers struggled to achieve four or five wins per season, the overall performance slowly improved and by 1975 the number of victories per season was in double figures.

From a humble beginning the present Brize Norton Cricket Club, and its enthusiastic Youth Section, have now become as well-known in West Oxfordshire and East Gloucestershire as any contemporary village side.
